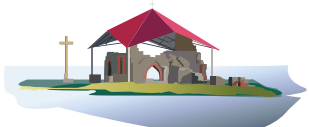


## IKŠKĪLE



### 1. Ikšķile church ruins on the St. Meinhard island

Ikšķile, Ogre municipality  
Ikšķile church ruins are the most ancient building ruins in the Baltics, located on a small island in the reservoir of Rīga hydro-power plant (HPP), called St. Meinhard Island. Ikšķile church was built in 1185 under the government of bishop Meinhard. After the filling of Rīga HPP reservoir in the 70s of the 20th century, it is encircled by the waters of the HPP. Nowadays the ruins are conserved, a roof is constructed over them. To see the ruins, you can get to the island by boat.

### 2. Ikšķile town beach

20 Rīga street, Ikšķile, Ogre municipality  
One of the most popular places for swimming in Ogre region. Parking, WC, changing cabin, children's playground, and a cafe are available. The Daugava river-bed is shallow here, which makes the beach especially suitable for recreation with children.

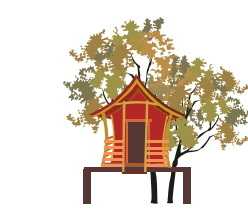
### 3. Chocolate Factory and Wine Tasting in Ikšķile

If you visit the chocolate factory "Rūgts Šokolāde" in Ikšķile, you will have an opportunity to learn how chocolate is made from real cocoa beans, to try several types of chocolate, and enjoy rich hot chocolate and chocolate tea. Whereas at Libertu winery you can book tastings during which you can enjoy birch sap, rhubarb and berry wine. During the visit, you will be offered 6 different wines, traditional wine appetizers – cheese and olives, as well as chocolate made from cocoa beans.

### 4. Boat rental in Ikšķile

Ikšķile Water and Recreation Sports Centre offers a variety of watercrafts for rent – rowboats, motorboats, water bikes, water bicycles, SUP boards, etc. Group trips to St. Meinhard's island and Death Island are available. A floating sauna is also available for rent.



### 5. Entertainment and event park "Kļavu Krasti" (Maple Riverbanks)

In "Kļavu krasti", adults and children can fulfil their childhood dream of having a treehouse. Children can try an obstacle course, a barefoot trail, and a small cycle track. This is a perfect place to celebrate children's birthdays, baptism, or simply to have a good time.

### 6. Wake park "Wild Wake"

"Wilde Wake" is a wake park by the lake Selēku. It is equipped with a modern cable and high quality constructions, produced specially for the place.

## TĪNŪŽI

### 7. Cultural heritage centre "Tīnūžu muiža" (Tīnūži manor)

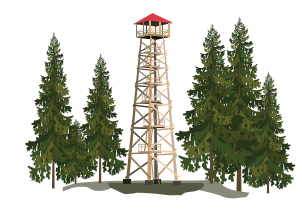
"Kraujas", Tīnūži parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26669452

Cultural heritage centre "Tīnūžu muiža" is located in a granary built in the 30s of the 20th century, and its primary exposition is devoted to the battles of Latvian Riflemen by the Mazā Jugla River in 1917. Here you can see unpublished photographs, weapons, uniforms, and different objects found in battlefields.

### 8. Turkalne Manor Barn

Turkalne, Tīnūži parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26355554, [www.turkalnesmuiža.lv](http://www.turkalnesmuiža.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
Turkalne manor barn was renovated in 2018. It currently produces 14 varieties of beer and 3 types of cider. It is located in the historical territory of Turkalne manor, which was established in 1604.

## OGRE



### 9. Nature park "Ogres Zīlie kalni" (The Ogre Blue Hills)

Ogre town and Tīnūži parish, +371 25732316, [www.ziliekalni.lv](http://www.ziliekalni.lv)

The Blue Hills are a chain of hillocks in an area of 312 ha – a part of The Great Eskers (Lielie Kangari). The major part of the territory is covered with coniferous forests on glaciofluvial eskers. The Blue Hills is a popular rest area for the residents of Ogre and guests of the town. In winter, cross-country skiing tracks with interesting relief are established, while in summer the path network is available to Nordic walkers, cyclists and other people interested in outdoor activities. There is an artificial lake by the name of Dubkalni water reservoir with a landscaped beach, recreational and camping areas. The viewing area offers a magnificent view of the Dubkalni Reservoir, while at the highest point of the nature park there is a 30 m high observation tower.

### 10. "Lavandu Lejas" (Lavender Valleys)

"Palejas", Tīnūži parish, Ogre municipality, +371 28809755, [www.lavandu-lejas.mozello.lv](http://www.lavandu-lejas.mozello.lv)  
A place created with love and care where visitors can find peace and enjoy the smell of lavender. The family-created lavender garden in summer season offers a calming walk

through lavender fields and a stone garden, as well as an opportunity to take pictures, enjoy rural nature and have a rest at specially equipped picnic places.



### 11. Historic Buildings and Square of Ogre town

Brīvības street in Ogre is outstanding with its architectural samples of the 20-ties and 30-ties of the 20th century. Nowadays, a great number of buildings are architectural monuments of regional or local importance. At the beginning of pedestrian section of Brīvības street, the facilitated square has become a popular gathering place for those living in Ogre as well as city guests. During the summer, residents and guests of the city can enjoy the complex of fountains, named "Digital water curtains", there is also a fountain that you can step in, a paddling fountain, especially appealing to the smallest visitors.



### 12. Ogre History and Art Museum

The modern interior features 2 constant exhibitions: 1) an informative exhibition about the development of the former bank building "From bank to museum"; 2) the engaging "Pietura Ogre" (train stop Ogre), which will appeal to all with its interactive and digital features, making it suited to all age groups. It's an exhaustive message of the history of Ogre. Applications possible to various educational programmes.



### 13. Krasta promenade in Ogre

Krasta street, Ogre  
The 2 km long promenade stretches along the Ogre River, revealing a magnificent view on the river and its banks. At the beginning of the promenade is a pedestrian bridge built in 1966, which connects

the central part of the city with the one on the other side – Pārogle [Over-The-Ogre-River]. It is the largest arc-shaped bridge in Latvia [94 m long, 4.5 m wide]. There are wooden footpaths across the river nearby, reminding the feeling of the 1920s and 1930s, when Ogre was a swimming resort. During winter season footpaths are dismantled. At the other end of the promenade, there is a new pedestrian bridge, which joins J. Čakstes Prospect and Ogres Street. Both bridges are lit up on special occasions.

### 14. The Daugava promenade

Kalna Prospect and Rīga Street intersection; Dambja street, Ogre  
The protecting dike in Ogre is a popular rest area and a place for walking, fishing and water sports for the residents of the town and its guests. The Promenade attracts visitors with an excellent view to the confluence of the River Daugava and the River Ogre. The pier built by the mouth of the River Ogre has become a unique place for recreation and walks. Sunsets are especially beautiful here. An environmental object has been created at the end of the Ogre pier – a lighthouse, with a moving ray of light advances from the top of the lighthouse in the dark. An environmental object in

the shape of three modern adolescents can also be viewed on the pier.



### 15. Špakovskis's Park "Lazdukalni"

6 Pavasara street, Ogre, +371 27083402  
The park covers 5,9 ha of the area. More than 400 species of bushes and trees from Western Europe, Siberia, Far East and even from the seacoast of the Pacific Ocean grow in the park. At the highest point in the park there is a viewing tower, accessible by a staircase of 100 steps and various other pathways. Entry to the park is free of charge.

### 16. A Deer Garden "Dobelnieki"

"Dobelnieki", Ogresgals parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26268464, [www.dobelnieki.lv](http://www.dobelnieki.lv)  
"Dobelnieki" is a family farm business that deals with raising deer. On the farm, one can see and feed red deer, go for walks, relax, or have a picnic with family and friends. The owners welcome guests during various festivities – stag nights and hen parties, weddings, birthdays, and others.

### 17. Creative house "Live Clay"

"Kieģelceplis", Tome parish, Ogre municipality, +371 29321337, 27752929. Advance booking for a visit is required!  
Provides creative workshops, wedding stops and tours in the world of clay. Opportunity to buy ceramic works and make individual orders.

## KEGUMS

### 18. Exhibition of the Museum of Energy

The exposition of the Enery Museum is located in Kegums - the place where the origins of the united Latvian energy supply are found. In the Museum, each and every person - from a curious child to an expert in the field - can gain new knowledge about the history and development of energy sector in Latvia. The outdoor exhibition acquaints visitors with large industrial exhibits in their natural environment - the turbine of the Kegums Hydropower Plant (HPP) installed in 1939, a part of the turbine from the Pļavinas HPP and other technological equipment.

### 19. Kegums view terrace and nature trail

8 Smiļšu street, Kegums, Ogre municipality  
A new recreation place for guests and locals - a viewing terrace, which has an artistically unique photo bench. There is also an informative stand, where the visualization and description of the construction of the historical bridge arches of Kegums HPP is depicted. This is the beginning of a 1 km long nature trail with stands displaying information about the history of the Kegums HPP, as well as the natural values of Kegums. Children and adults will enjoy educational environmental pieces, such as a puzzle about plants and fishes, or educational benches about different types of rocks.

### 20. "Un:Te candles"

1D Celtnieku street, Kegums, Ogre municipality, +371 22011989, 26167184 Advance booking for a masterclass is required!  
The shop, where a particularly harmonious atmosphere is created, also has a candle-making factory. Here you can buy a range of different colors, sizes of paraffin candles. It is also possible to apply for candle making masterclasses, where you will be able to make gorgeous candles

under the guidance of experienced masters and get acquainted with preparation technology.

### 21. Water sports base "WindBorn" and Kegums beach

14A Lāčplēša street, Kegums, Ogres municipality, +371 27011410, [www.windborn.eu](http://www.windborn.eu)

"WindBorn" recreation base is located in a beautiful place on Kegums beach, offering various activities on the water - SUP board and catamaran rental, windsurfing and Wind Wing training. SUP sunrise and sunset rides as well as expeditions are organized. In the "Wind-Born Surf Cafe" you can enjoy a variety of drinks and other delicacies.

### 22. Kegums Cross Hill

10 Meža street, Kegums, Ogres municipality, +371 26792091  
The first cross here was placed in 1997. It was made at the suggestion of the local resident I. Brokāne. Over the years smaller and larger crosses from around the world have been placed here brought by pilgrims.

## LIELVĀRDE

### 23. Uldevena castle and Rembate park

The 12th century Latvian wooden castle was built by Agris Liepiņš based on specifications found in archeological materials. Visitors can see residential areas with small cabins, potter and blacksmith workshops, reconstructed period garments and gain extensive information about life in the late iron age. Rembate Park is 11 ha large protected nature area of national importance. The park was originally developed as a landscape area around the Rembate Manor. The pond in the center of the park surrounds a small island accessible on foot. The island was named Spīdala Island in 1968 [a character in Latvian folk epic poem "Lāčplēsis"]. Spīdala Island and the park as a whole serve as the venue for many and varied events.



### 24. The Andrejs Pumpurs Museum in Lielvārde

The Andrejs Pumpurs Museum has been located in the old Lielvārde Manor granary on the banks of the river Daugava ever since its opening in 1970. At the museum it is not only possible to gain information about the Latvian national hero Lāčplēsis, the author of the epic poem Andrejs Pumpurs, but also about Lielvārde and the Lielvārde belt.

### 25. Lielvārde Evangelical Lutheran Church

21 E. Kauliņa aleja, Lielvārde, Ogre municipality, +371 22138025, 29195107  
The church was built in 1747, but it was demolished in World War I. Renovation was completed in 1932 and in 1938 the church received its altar painting "Jēzus Getzemes dārzs" [Jesus in the Garden of Getsemane] by Kārlis Miesnieks. President Kārlis Ulmanis financed the interior work. The church is an architectural monument of national importance. By prior agreement, it is possible to see the interior of the church and to climb the tower.

### 26. Lielvārde Park and medieval castle ruins

Lielvārdes parks, Lielvārde, Ogres municipality  
The Medieval Castle Ruins in Lielvārde are an archaeological monument of national importance. The stone castle and rampart was built at the beginning of the 13th century according to German Crusader instructions on the site of the ancient Livonian wooden castle. It was damaged by repeated war activity and was renewed several times, but since 1613, only ruins remain. The territory is home to numerous protected dendrological species. A Sculpture Garden is located in the park on the site of the old Lielvārde Manor - complete with six columns, terraces and rose gardens. The 16 wooden sculptures depict various characters from the famous Latvian epic poem "Lāčplēsis".

## BIRZGALE



### 27. Linde Manor Ruins, Park and Gate

"Ezeriņi", Birzgale parish, Ogre municipality  
Linde manor park was built from 1767-1772, where an interesting phenomenon is the Dutch linden tree plantations which seem to be growing with the roots up. Linde Manor belonged to the family of Baron von Plettenberg, who built it in the 16th century. During World War I it was heavily bombed and not rebuilt. In 1767, Georg Friedrichson von Plettenberg built the Linde Manor Gate in Baroque style, which is the only surviving part of the manor complex to this day. Gate and park are architectural monuments of national importance.

## JUMPRAVA

### 28. Beekeepers "Lūšu drava"

"Stropēni", Lielvārde parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26353518, [www.lusudrava.lv](http://www.lusudrava.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
During the excursion beekeepers will talk about the profession, look at tools, become acquainted with the life cycle of the bee and its importance in the construction of the world. Tasting of the products of Lūšu Drava also is available.

### 29. Cider brewery Mr. Plūme

"Zīles", Jumprava parish, Ogre municipality, +371 29631631, 28465427, [www.mrpplume.lv](http://www.mrpplume.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
Cider master Mr. Plūme ferments natural apple cider putting to use the extensive experience he has gained over the years. Only natural materials are used in the fermentation process with neither pasteurization nor additives. Excursions offer exciting stories about the production of cider and the opportunity to sample various cider types.

### 30. Bakery "Bricēni"

"Bricēni", Lēdmane parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26957559, [bricenimaize.lv](http://bricenimaize.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
The bakery offers two different group programmes: baking the special homemade "Bricēnu" pizza and a masterclass for baking naturally leavened bread. From this practical activity, you can learn about the differences between the types of flour and make your own loaf of bread. Find out how to obtain your own leaven and receive information about the 43-hour long fermentation process until the dough is ready. While the bread is baking, you can view the farm and enjoy delicious homemade "Bricēnu" pancakes.

## LĒDMANE

### 31. Recreation center "Trušu Karaliste" (The Rabbit Kingdom)

"Druvas", Lēdmane parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26068336, 27016720, [www.trusukaraliste.lv](http://www.trusukaraliste.lv)  
On the banks of the Ogre River, an area measuring several hectares, is known as "The Rabbit Kingdom". The area is inhabited by rabbits of all sizes and colors. The rabbits inhabit castles and manors that have been built and shaped to fit into the surrounding landscape.

### 32. Amusement Park "ABpark"

"ABpark", Lēdmane parish, Ogre municipality, +371 27336600, [www.abpark.lv](http://www.abpark.lv)  
The park offers a wide range of fun activities for families with children aged up to 14. In the "ABpark" you can discover the prehistoric world, walk along the 1 km long nature trail of dinosaurs. Kids can also have fun in the water playground and enjoy various types of attractions, such as catamarans, carousels, virtual reality rides, go-kart tracks and many more. The park is located by the motorway P80 Tīnūži-Koknese. Open from May until October.

## KRAPE

### 33. Winery "Lauskis"

"Lauski", Lēdmane parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26052137, [www.krapesmuiža.lv](http://www.krapesmuiža.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
The tour offers wine tasting in mystery-and-ghost-story-surrounded 300-year-old manor cellars with the owner telling about the wine-making process. After the tasting, you can take a walk through the Krape manor park and see the secular oaks and scenic views on the banks of the Lobe River.

### 34. "Skaņumāja" - The Exhibition of Latvian Traditional Musical Instruments

"ABpark", Lēdmane parish, Ogre municipality, +371 26656965, 22455879  
The church was constructed in 1795 with the support of the Schoen-vogels, the owners of Menģele manor. Over the centuries, there have been no significant changes made. The core of the building is made of stone, but the tower is wooden. In the centre of the altar, which was built in the 1840s, there is the painting "Golgotha" by G. R. Karing, painted in 1846 and restored in 1987. The organ was built in 1933 by H. Kolbe. The building is an architectural monument of national importance.

The community "Skaņumāja" displays a collection of traditional musical instruments. Here, you can learn about the instruments made and played in Latvia over the last 100 years, and follow their development, listen to the sounds they make or try to play them.

## MADLIENA

### 35. Krape Manor Water Mill

"Udensdzirnavas", Krape parish, Ogre municipality, +371 29258675, [www.krapesmuiža.lv](http://www.krapesmuiža.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
The Krape manor watermill offers educational tours. Depending on the season, you can learn stories about the watermill and its structure, see the trout and feed African catfish (in summer). Here you can apply for candle casting classes or take part in the Krapes crepes pancake workshop.

### 36. Madliena Evangelical Lutheran Church

Madliena, Ogre municipality, +371 26113320  
One of the oldest churches in Latvia, dating back to the 13th century. The pulpit and the altar elements were crafted by K. F. Hüns – an organist and long-term teacher at Madliena parish school. The altarpiece "Kristus pie krus-ta" [Christ on the Cross] was painted in 1844 by G. R. Karing. Around 1780, G. Merkel was ordained in the church of Madliena.

### 37. Plātere Castle Mound

Madliena parish, Ogre municipality, GPS 56.8397, 25.2065  
According to separate finds, the hill was inhabited between the 5th and 12th centuries. During the 1860s, E. Tiesenhausen, the landlord of Plātere, issued an order to build artificial castle ruins which have been partially preserved. The castle mound is an archaeological monument of national importance.

## MEŅĢELE

### 38. Meņģele Evangelical Lutheran Church

Meņģele parish, Ogre municipality, GPS 56.8388, 25.3560  
The tower is located in the territory of the nature park "Ogres ieleja" [Ogre Valley]. It offers a wonderful view over the valley of the Ogre River, as well as the Aderkaši Orthodox Church. Meņģele rural territory is the place where the famous Latvian writer Sudrabu Ežūzs, the author of a story about a curious boy named Crazy Dauka [Dullais Dauka], was born and spent his youth. An oak-and-birch grove on the bank of the river Ogre was a favourite place of rest for the writer.



### 39. Meņģele viewing tower and Crazy Dauka's (Dullais Dauka) grove

Meņģele parish, Ogre municipality, GPS 56.8388, 25.3560  
The tower is located in the territory of the nature park "Ogres ieleja" [Ogre Valley]. It offers a wonderful view over the valley of the Ogre River, as well as the Aderkaši Orthodox Church. Meņģele rural territory is the place where the famous Latvian writer Sudrabu Ežūzs, the author of a story about a curious boy named Crazy Dauka [Dullais Dauka], was born and spent his youth. ## LĪČUPE

### 40. Nature Park "Ogres ieleja" (The Ogre Valley)

Its area covers 7515.7 ha and is located in the municipal territories of Madona and Ogre. The nature park "The Ogre Valley" is included in the network of European nature protection areas „Natura 2000”. The park has such treasures as the unregulated Ogre River, its valley with splendid riverbank surroundings, river rapids, steep banks and heritage trees. The suspension bridge in Ogresmuiža is the most convenient starting point for the 163rd cycling route named "Ogres ielejas aplis" [The Ogre Valley Circle]. About 2 km from the bridge, there is a viewing platform offering a magnificent view of the Ogre River valley.

### 41. The Devil's Ditch on the Nāružiņa River

Mazozoli parish, Ogre municipality, GPS 56.9296, 25.5378  
The Devils Ditch is a 30-m-long accumulation of large, green moss-covered rocks in a deep and heavily forested part of the Nāružiņa, a 12-km-long tributary of the Ogre River. That is how the location got its name. During the summer, the water flows among the stones calmly, but, in spring, the water rushes and foams up over the rocks.

## TAURUPE

### 42. Boat Rentals on Lake Plaudis

"Laivu māja", Taurupe parish, Ogre municipality, +371 20554488, [www.plaudis.lv](http://www.plaudis.lv)  
Boat, paddle-boat and SUP board rentals there are at the landscaped beach. Tent places by the lake.

## KEIPENE

### 43. Keipene rampart

Keipene parish, Ogre municipality, GPS 56.8860, 25.1995  
The Keipene rampart is a range of sandy hill-ocks stretching for 7 km in length and up to 1 km in width, which rises above the surrounding areas and offers beautiful scenery for tens of kilometres away. The highest points are Kārķu Hill [142 m above sea level] and Lakstene Hill [151 m above sea level]. One can enjoy the magnificent surroundings while driving on the P4 road between Keipene and Taurupe.



### 44. Keipene Cinema Station

"Dzelzcēļa stacija", Keipene parish, Ogre municipality, +371 65033717, 25577645  
A cinema station built inside the former railway station Keipene. In the waiting room, there is an exhibition dedicated to the film director Sergei Eisenstein. There are environmental installations in the vicinity of the station – a lighthouse with mailboxes dedicated to the documentary film director Juris Podnieks, a gigantic table for the prodigies of filmmaking, a tunnel made of movie frames and an environmental installation Potemkin's Well created as an underground exhibition hall.

## SUNTAŽI

### 45. Brewery "IndieJānis"

"Kalts", Upespils, Suntaži parish, Ogre municipality, +371 29760218, [www.indiejanis.mozello.lv](http://www.indiejanis.mozello.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
On a tour of the beer brewery in Upespils,

Suntaži parish, you will get to know how beer is made. Whether in a small or large group, Jānis Rudzītis, the owner of the brewery, will welcome you and show you the facility, tell you its history, and treat you to beer. You will learn everything there is to know about brewing. The brewery was established in the barn of Kastrāne Manor, built in 1810, where revolutionary gatherings were held in 1905.

### 46. "Aļaska" - tower of obstacle course

"Copes", Suntaži parish, Ogre municipality, +371 22000099, 29414141, [www.copes.lv](http://www.copes.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!  
The Adventure Park offers active recreation to challenge oneself to overcome obstacles in a tower of a unique design. There are 25 different attractions on the tower and the surrounding pillar system at the height of 3/6/9/12 m. The park also has two beach volleyball courts, a fitness equipment complex and obstacle courses for children.

### 47. "StarSpace" Observatory

"Kaltīni", Suntaži parish, Ogre municipality, +371 29120445, [www.starspace.lv](http://www.starspace.lv) Advance booking for a visit is required!

In the observatory, you can listen to stories about space, learn practical skills in searching for constellations, and observe the stars through the most powerful publicly available private telescope. During the summer months, it is possible to see the farm animals.

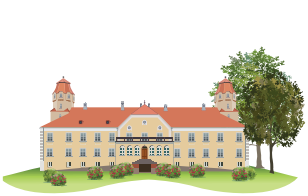
### 48. Suntaži Evangelical Lutheran Church

Suntaži, Ogre municipality, +371 26343062  
The church was built in 1780–1782, following the design of the architect C. Haberland, and was reconstructed in 1874. The church houses one of the largest bells of all rural Lutheran churches in Latvia. It weighs 1.4 tons. The church is an architectural monument of national importance. By prior agreement, it is possible to see the interior of the church.

### 49. Suntaži Manor House and Museum

Suntaži, Ogre municipality, +371 26682339  
The manor house was built from 1780 to 1782 and modernised in the middle of the 19th century, giving it a neo-gothic appearance. It was destroyed and restored several times.

After the damage in 1905, the castle was restored by its last owner Baron von Hahnenfeld. Since 1920, a school has been operating in the castle. By prior agreement, it is possible to see the interior of the castle and to climb the castle tower to enjoy the beautiful view of the surroundings.



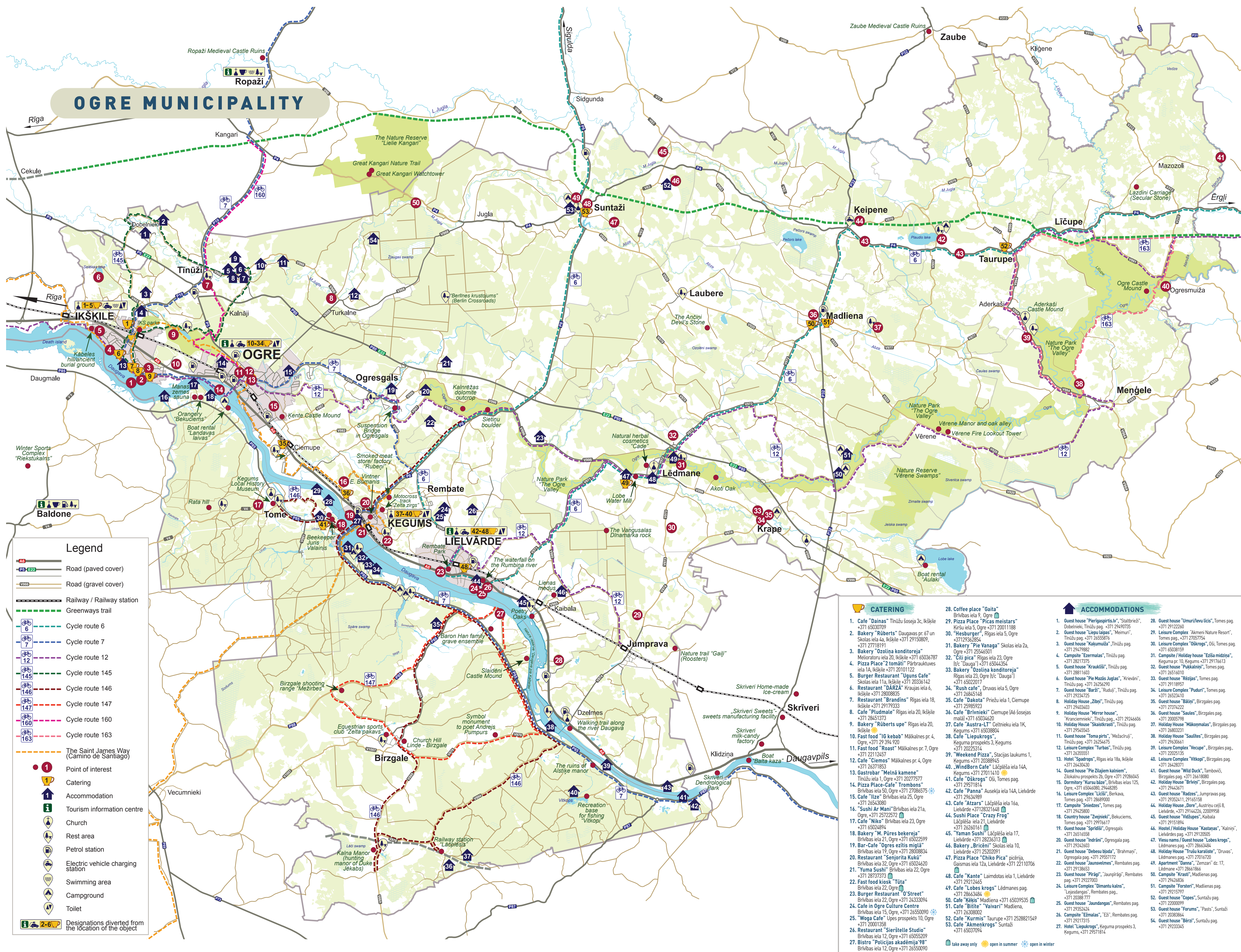
### 50. Koderi Castle Mound (The Big Man's Bed)



Suntaži parish, Ogre municipality, GPS 56.9076, 24.7696  
The Koderi castle mound is located on the right bank of the river Maza Jugla in the range of hills called "Lielie Kangari" that stretch parallel to the river. The castle mound is an archaeological monument of national importance.
